Abstract: Medical and scientific technology allow us to significantly alter aspects of human life. In this constantly changing field of bioethics, issues are constantly evolving and these issues are discussed in this volume. Issues such as: cloning, stem cell research and same-sex marriage are discussed. The third edition has 120 new articles, among them Artificial nutrition and hydration, Bioterrorism, Cloning, Cybernetics, Dementia, Managed care, and Nanotechnology.
