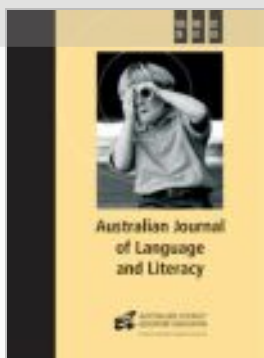

**Abstract:** This paper explores the role that masculinity plays in a group of adolescent boys' reading preferences and involvement in literacy. Selected interviews and an extended response survey are used to explore the extent to which 'regimes of masculinity' are implicated in boys' literacy practices. The works of Brian Moon, Jan Hunter and Michel Foucault are drawn on to provide a theoretical basis for undertaking this kind of analysis. The implications of the research for classroom teachers are also elaborated.
