## Abstract

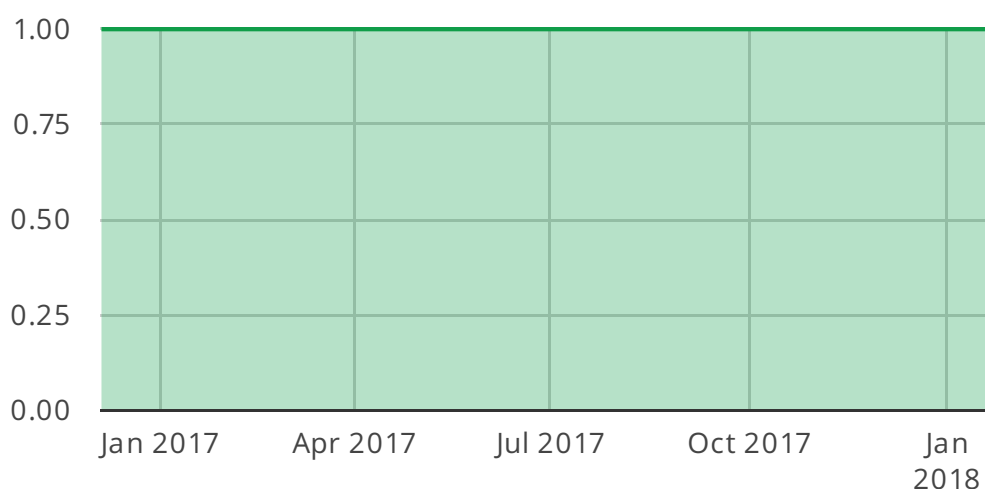
