Abstract : Part 1 of this fourth volume (Oecophoridae to Scythrididae) covers Oecophoridae and all the smaller families, whilst the Gelechiidae are covered

The introductory chapter concerns the ecology and evolution of lepidoptera against bats. The systematic section begins with the scheme of classification chapters on the Oecophoridae, Ethmiidae, Autostichidae, Blastobasidae, Bat Agonoxenidae, Momphidae, Cosmopterigidae and Scythrididae. A checklist of Irish species is given for each family. There are genitalia drawings of both species, and also representative figures of wing venation for each family as diagnostic characters. Each species account includes a full description, details and a distribution map (including some records for 2001). An index of host plants is provided.
