The great Netherlandish painter Hieronymus Bosch took his name from the town in which he spent most of his life, 's-Hertogenbosch, near Antwerp in northern Brabant. However, he was born Jeronimus van Aken, his surname possibly indicating the family's origins in Aachen, Germany. Both his father and grandfather were accomplished artists. It is somehow fitting that very little else is known about the life of this enigmatic painter. An orthodox

Catholic, he became a prominent member of a religious brotherhood, but his characteristic paintings are so bizarre that there has been endless speculation as to their true religious sources. Bosch married well and his professional fame and success extended well beyond the boundaries of the parochial town in which he lived. The origins of his style and technique are far from clear; his manner has little in common with his immediate...
