The annual SB&F competition, sponsored by AAAS and funded by Subaru, is intended to promote science literacy and to encourage the writing and publishing of high-quality science books for children and young adults. published between September 2014 and September 2015. Winners in each category will be announced at the upcoming AAAS Annual Meeting in Washington, D.C. Can you guess which ones will take home the prize?
