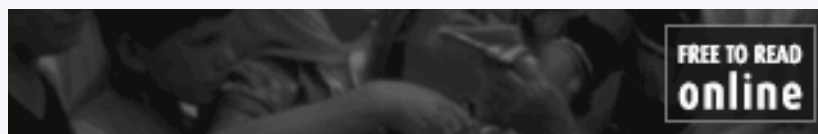

Some form of material or symbolic reparation has been a part of many transitional justice processes. Germany paid reparations both to individual victims of the Holocaust and to the state of Israel. Reparations in various forms have been paid in South Africa to victims of apartheid. The US paid reparations to Japanese-Americans confined to internment camps during World War II. Since the mid-19th century, reparations have been sought as partial redress for slavery, the Jim Crow laws and the legacy of lynching in the US. Material and symbolic reparations have also played a central role in justice initiatives and justice demands in Nicaragua, Peru, Morocco, Diego Garcia, Belize, Guatemala, Cyprus and Israel, to name a few.
