Abst

Why do humanitarian principles, human rights and other 'rules' of the reality of assistance delivery, whilst reality does not dint these obligations? This book investigates the international assistance given in countries at war. In the Democratic Republic of Congo and southern Sudan, it finds that a number of staff to justify their operational weaknesses by blaming or discrediting their activity as illegitimate, forestalling dialogue, limiting aid organisation and ultimately questioning the sincerity of the assistance. The book questions the 'rules' of assistance – as assistance is not meaningfully 'ruled' by the game'.
