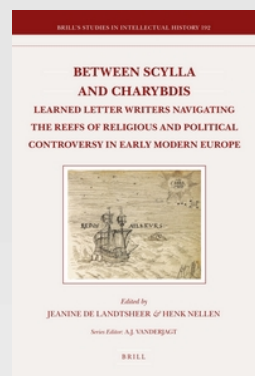

Chapter Summary

The period of the Twelve Years Truce between the Southern and the Northern Netherlands (1609-1621) was one of seventeenth-century Dutch history. At the heart of the truce controversies that made the period of the Truce so turbulent was the struggle to preserve the peace in church and country by a scholarly approach to the problems of that period: the Leiden theologian Hugo Grotius; the rector of the Latin School of Dordrecht, Gerardus Joannes Vossius; and the famous scholar and diplomat Hugo Grotius. This book presents the history of these scholars in seven snapshots. Vossius, Vorstius and Grotius tried to point out a safe middle course, but their signals were not received or were taken amiss. Vossius and Grotius painfully had to rebuke Vorstius, who did not even live to see.
