John Murray and Paper Deterioration

In *Books & Documents*, by Julius Grant, published in London in 1937, mention is made of a John Murray and his observations on faults in paper in a brief book with a title-page dated 1824. Paying tribute to Murray's perspicacity, Grant said, he "even manages to put his finger on two of the principal causes of the trouble, namely excessive acidity and over-bleaching."¹

Apart from the recognition by Grant, who gave a generous quotation from Murray because of its historical interest for the student of paper, Murray, the man and his work, seem to have been largely forgotten by the time of his death in 1851 and in the years subsequent. This has been unfortunate, because if more attention had been paid to Murray's observations on papermaking practices and the need for improvement the problem of paper deterioration might have been lessened for us today and additional investigation of this subject might have been hastened by decades.

Stranraer, at the head of Loch Ryan, on the western coast of Scotland, had a reputation for being a safe harbor. It was therefore an appropriate place for a sea captain, in this instance James Murray, to reside, and it was there that to him and his wife, Grace, was born their son John about 1786.² John Murray seems to have been largely self-educated, though at the time of his death he was described as "Ph.D., M.A., &c.,"³ and to have interested himself early in scientific subjects.

When Murray's remarks on paper deterioration appeared he was already well embarked upon a career of writing and lecturing and was (in 1815) the author of a work entitled *The Elements of Chemical Science*. The book from which Grant drew his quotation was *Observations and Experiments on the Bad Composition of Modern Paper*, and it was to be followed in 1829 by an expanded version, *Practical Remarks on Modern Paper*.⁴ *Observations and Experiments* was itself, however, an expansion of a communication from Murray to the *Gentleman's Magazine*. Quaintly enough, it all began with mermaids.

In the December issue of the widely read magazine for 1822, under the title "The Mermaid Exhibiting in London", the editor reprinted some "judicious remarks, by J. Murray, F.L.S." which had "lately appeared in the
