Both these volumes concerning John Muir and his friends reflect, with some sadness I think, on a vanished lifestyle. Take letters: they were the staple of personal communication in Muir's America. Often long, thoughtful, and carefully handwritten, important letters were tied into bundles and cherished. Recipients

reread them, like favorite books, at special moments or in special places. "I have," John Muir wrote Jeanne Carr, "been out on..."
