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Evolving Environmentalism: The Role of Ecotheology in Creation/Evolution Controversies



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The impact on ecological theology of green and postmodern critiques of science has led to disturbing parallels between environmentalists and process theologians on the one hand, and the arguments of Intelligent Design (ID) proponents on the other. One of the main reasons for this is that these critiques is a rejection of mechanistic science and "neo-Darwinism". Both ID proponents and ecotheologists share a reductionist worldview assumed to be central to neo-Darwinism. Both groups also redefine the traditional boundaries of science, presenting a form of biology that shows matter to be active and valuable, rather than dead and inert. This paper e
