Wilfred Ruprecht Bion (1897–1979)

With the death of Wilfred Ruprecht Bion in Oxford on 8 November 1979, psychoanalysis lost or distinguished practitioners and original thinkers. Building on the work of Freud and Melanie Klein understanding of psychotic thought processes well beyond the previous limits. In doing this he also shed new light on normal thinking and the emotional factors which differentiate the psychotic from the neurotic. His writings are exciting and stimulating to his psychoanalytic colleagues because of his new ways of looking at things. They are also difficult and call for considerable work and effort to understand them; but to meet his challenge is to be aware of being in the presence of an immensely powerful intellect who in conversation was as simple and direct.

Wilfred Bion was born on 8 September 1897, in Muttra, in what were then the United Provinces of India. His father was working there as a Civil Engineer. Besides being a skilled engineer, he was a trusted administrator and identified with the Indian scene since he served for part of his time there as Secretary to the Indian government. His mother seems to have been a simpler person with an intuitive approach which must have meant a lot to a young son, who remained deeply devoted to her.

India made a lasting impression on him and he maintained his interest in that country to the end of his life. That shortly before his death he was planning to visit Bombay to work with the psychoanalytic group there is a further indication of his deep interest in the country.
