Abstract

Based on two richly described case studies – a Pentecostal worship service and a live performance – this book draws on sociology, theology and religious studies in order to explore ecstatic experience in these contexts. Interviews with performers in both settings, along with recordings of worship services and live performances, combine to create a picture of ecstatic experience as a catalysing ecstasy. Drawing on the work of thinkers as diverse as William James and Friedrich Schleiermacher, this book demonstrates that religious understandings can work in a complementary fashion to help us understand ecstatic experience. Ultimately, the argument put forward is that ecstatic experience has a place in both religious and secular settings and is best understood as a human experience working together. The ecstatic experience common to both contexts is identified as the kernel from which religion may develop.
