Abstract : Tourism is the growth industry of the 1990s. The past decade has seen an enormous expansion in the number of visitors coming to Australia and an increasing recognition of the financial significance of tourism. This book examines issues such as the development and structure of the Australian tourism industry. Rather than

a static picture of tourism in Australia, the book discusses some potential future directions for which tourism can take. In particular, it seeks to address the critical issue of whether or not that tourism plays a positive, long-term role in developing Australia in a manner that is both environmentally and socially acceptable. Each chapter discusses a component of tourism in Australia and the issues which have emerged during the development of that segment of the industry within the framework of sustainable tourism development. Topics discussed include the scope of tourism studies, the history of tourism in Australia, the role of government and tourism, industry and labour, tourism planning, the economic impacts of tourism, the social impacts of tourism, the environmental impacts of tourism, and the opportunities for the Australian tourism industry and the future direction of the industry.

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
