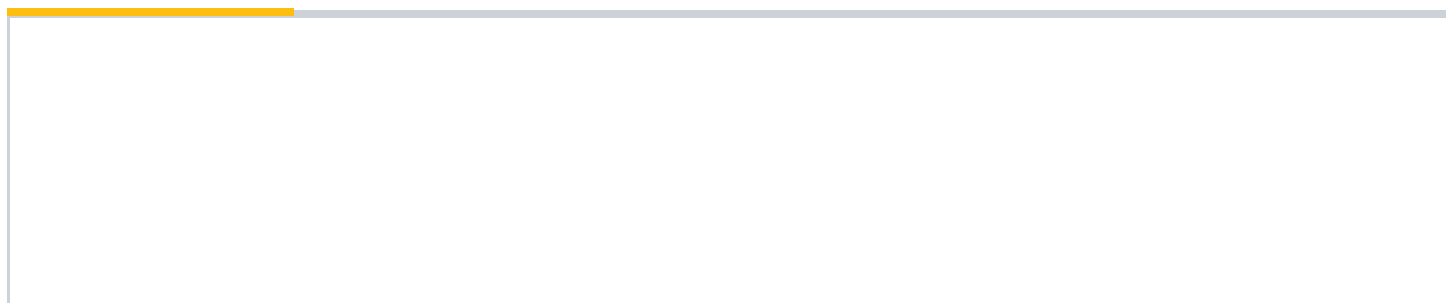

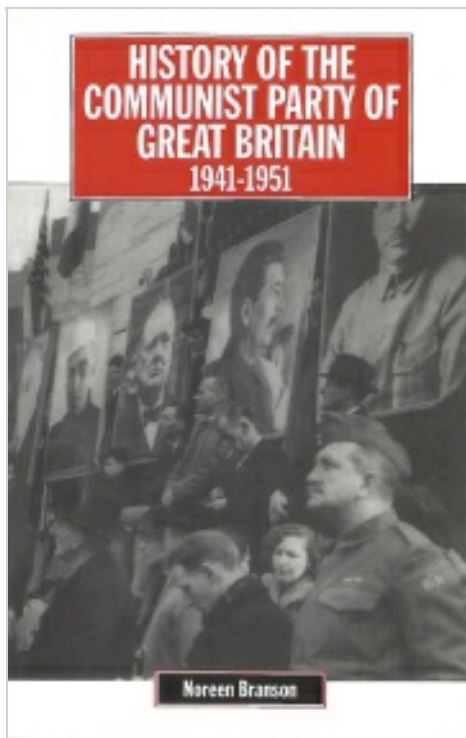

SUMMARY
