Abstract:

This book provides a critical insight into the limits of the contemporary system for conflict management and the author investigates the reasons why the wide-ranging efforts to forestall violence in Rwanda in 1994 failed. He traces the individual and collective impact of official and unofficial mediation efforts, peace-keeping missions and humanitarian aid. He uses theoretical and empirical evidence to demonstrate that the failure of the peace process was due to a combination of factors: the lack of connection among the various attempts at conflict resolution; the intransigence of the warring parties; the lack of a coherent strategy for managing spoilers in the peace process; and weak international support. The author concludes with recommendations for reform of the international conflict management system.
