This article explores the existence of theodic elements within the book of Lamentations. Drawing on the typology Moor (*Theodicy in the World of the Bible* [Leiden, 2003]) it is identified that Lamentations explores both retributive its poems. Other theodic solutions are not, however, present. Although these theodic solutions are present, it can constitutes a theodicy as such.
