Abstract : A survey of the mountain area, which comprises three-quarters of the area of the Territory, was made firstly to ascertain the extent and seriousness of the deterioration of the pastures. The original grassland comprises some of the best pasturage in South Africa and is particularly suitable for the production of the best wool. The area is also of great importance as a watershed.

The percentage loss in carrying capacity in representative vegetation types and recommendations are made regarding the necessity for limitation of stock
