ABSTRACT

The focus for students of Latin America in the past decade has been on 'tide' presidencies attempting to bring about social and economic change. Attention has been paid to the rightwing political forces resisting such change. These include political parties, business, the private media and other social and cultural institutions. In recent years its activities have often appeared to challenge international diplomacy.

Based on a variety of original fieldwork and evidence, this volume addresses the situation in Latin America in the face of leftist governments, the discrediting of neo-liberalism, and includes chapters on US policy towards Latin America; the role of US-business and of the private media; as well as offering country-specific studies of opposition to left-of-centre governments in Venezuela, Bolivia and Cuba. A revealing and important book for anyone interested in contemporary Latin America.
