Abstract : Although many of the techniques described in the first edition of this book have not been revised, others have been refined and improvements in procedures, indications, limitations and complications have been made. Two procedures "preparation by penile fixation" and "treatment of vaginal prolapse by fixation of the prepubic tendon" have been added to the bovine section. The section on the horse has been changed the most. Three new procedures "superior check ligament tenotomy" and "deep digital flexor tenotomy" and "tooth removal" in a llama have been added. The first 8 chapters cover general aspects of surgery (presurgical considerations, anesthesia, aseptic technique, etc.).

anaesthesia, fluid therapy, surgical instruments, suture material and needle ligatures, suture patterns, wounds and drainage, and reconstructive surgery. There are 4 chapters on equine surgery (orthopaedic, urogenital, respiratory and gastrointestinal), 3 on bovine (gastrointestinal, urogenital, miscellaneous) and 1 miscellaneous (dehorning goat and tooth removal in a llama). The text is supported by diagrams.
