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This large, flat and open campground is located on the Aire River where fishing and canoeing can be enjoyed. It is a great place for large groups to camp. Please check Park information as flats are prone to flooding and may be closed.

Campsites

There are 40 campsites available accommodating a n people per site. All campsites are unpowered. Sites 1-4 sites 27-40 are suitable for large caravans; sites 7-11 small caravans; sites 12-16 are suitable for tents only. suitable for tents, camper-trailers, campervans or rec

Facilities

Non-flush toilets, a picnic shelter, shared picnic tables, information, access to the Great Ocean Walk, shared boat landing are available.

Campfire

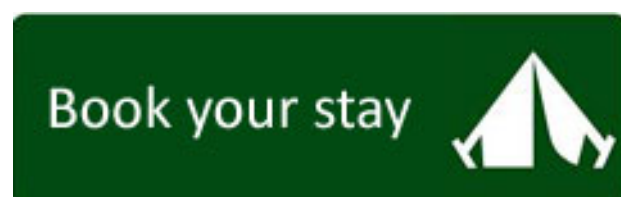
Only allowed in fireplaces provided – supply your own or your own gas barbeque are preferred for cooking.

Water

Some water is available but is not suitable for drinking own.

Rubbish

There is no rubbish collection at this campground. Ple rubbish with you.



Campfire guidelines

- Light fires only in the fireplaces provided or use camping stove instead

- Ensure fires are never left unattended and are extinguished before you leave
- During summer and autumn Total Fire Bans are in place which means no open fires can be lit

Great Ocean Walk hike-in and group campsites

There is also a purpose-built Great Ocean Walk hike-in and a group camping area.

The hike-in campsite has eight individual campsites set in surrounding bushland. Each camp pad has room for a maximum of 12 people per hiker party, but no more than four hike-in campsites at each location.

The group camping area offers larger and more open campsites for groups up to 16 people with enough room for eight 2-person tents.

Fees apply at these hike-in and group campsites and should be paid in advance.

Online booking tip: Overnight hikes are booked per person per night, so set your booking search criteria to 1 night and 1 accommodation site to see results for all available sites.

Accessibility information

(For visitors with mobility limitations)

Access is via Horden Vale Road, Horden Vale. This road has several steep sections and crosses Aire River on a single lane timber

Facilities

Parking

There is designated parking on a level compacted grass close to the picnic area. There are no designated disabled

Picnic area

The picnic area has a number of picnic tables and a row on a flat grassed area adjacent to the camping ground bench seats on two sides and sufficient underneath space for wheelchairs or strollers. There are also some fireplaces barbecue hotplates.
