Abstract : The author describes this work as "a review for the general reader of Liberty Hyde Bailey's life story, his background, personality and achievements".

It does not pretend to be a detailed analysis of his scientific contributions, though they cannot be excluded from any book purporting to outline Bailey's life. The English-speaking horticulturist perhaps his most outstanding contribution to the field were the various Cyclopaedias of Horticulture for which he was responsible. They hold their own with any in the field. Yet despite his publications, which probably number several hundreds, his greatest achievement surely lay in raising the standard of horticultural learning and education throughout the world, chiefly by his dor

scene at Cornell for 25 years in the heyday of his life from 1888 to 1913. Ag retired then from a life of organizing the student to an even more strenuous horticultural investigation and discovery, which brought renown to America and enlightenment to horticulturists everywhere. On his 90th birthday he went to Indian jungle searching for rare plants and palms. He returned to give a speech of his tour at the postponed birthday party. Two years later he was all set for palms in Nigeria and an advisory visit to the Belgian Congo, where, as everywhere, his advice was still in demand. But a stumble just before he was about to start a bad accident and complete recovery was denied him. He died in his 97th year. This inspiring and gracious small book is worth reading. D.A.
